### Introduction

- 27,300 + Ukrainians in Ireland <sup>1</sup>
- 85% women and children <sup>1</sup>
- 18,000 still requiring accommodation <sup>1</sup>









## **National Response**



- Temporary Protection Directive grants temporary protection of Ukrainians in Ireland
- Equal access to education provided as a result

#### Structure adopted:

- Regional Education and Language Teams (REALT) Teams developed for primary/ post primary education
- Hosted by the 16 regional Education and Training Boards (ETBs) nationally working independently but collectively



## Challenges

- Accommodation
- Securing school places and childcare support
- English language proficiency
- ESOL provision capacity in Ireland
- Access to and orientation within the FET system





## **Survey & Case Studies**

#### **Survey:**

- Conducted across all 16 ETBs
- Need for intensive ESOL Tutor recruitment drive
- Need for ESOL Tutor Training identified for existing and prospective tutors
- Training surrounding supporting learners exhibiting trauma identified

#### **Case Studies:**

- LCETB and Kerry College experience
  Good practice identified:
- Services brought direct to accommodation centres
- Partnerships with LCDC
- Involving Ukrainian nationals in information provision and education support
- Development of migrant specific Guidance Worker posts




