Alexandra Teixteira, Director of the Adult Qualifications Unit (National Agency for Qualifications and Vocational Training), highlighted the challenges facing adult learners in Portugal and government action in the field of adult education. Rita Alves and Joana Santiao from the Center for Qualifications and Andreia Lopes, HR Director at Lidl (for the central region), presented examples of good practice in cooperation between educational institutions and the labor market. It was inspiring to hear how the company encourages its employees to continue their education and training, as they provide (and finance) training to more than 100 employees each year.

The presentation of Hugo Martinez's methodologies and practices in adult education was an introduction to working in groups, where we focused on the challenges faced by educational institutions on the one hand and adult educators on the other.
